

Compact Eligibility Requirements:

- You must hold a full, unrestricted medical license in a Compact Member State that are available to serve as an SPL (please see map on home page).
- AND at least one of the below must apply:
 - a. Your primary residence is in the SPL (State of Principal Licensure)
 - b. At least 25% of your practice of medicine occurs in the SPL
 - c. Your employer is located in the SPL
 - d. You use the SPL as your state of residence for U.S. federal income tax purposes

You must maintain your SPL status at all times. You may re-designate your SPL after receiving your original Letter of Qualification.

- Have graduated from an accredited medical school, or a school listed in the International Medical Education Directory
- Successful completion of ACGME or AOA accredited graduate medical education



- Passed each component of the USMLE, COMLEX-USA, or equivalent in no more than three attempts
- Hold a current specialty certification or time-unlimited certification by an ABMS or AOABOS board
- Must not have any history of disciplinary actions toward your medical license
- Must not have any criminal history
 - Must not have any history of controlled substance actions toward your license
- Must not currently be under investigation
